



Top Gun Airway

Dryden Ambulance Inc. will be hosting a new Advanced Airway Management course on December 12th and 19th. This course is designed to be a two day Advanced Airway Management course that will cover a variety topics from basic BLS airway, Capnography, Apneic Oxygenation, to Bougie, Surgical airways, RSI and vent management. This course will have lectures, discussion and skill session lab to perform airway procedures. This course is not intended to educate you how to do intubation skill, but rather to perform Airway Management and think about the process. Are their better ways to manage the airway and produce positive patient outcomes?

This is course has been developed with current evidence based medicine and the latest science about airway management. As such, you will be required to download the pre-reading assignments, watch the videos and be prepared to discuss the topics on the first day of the class. You are also required to complete the pre-celebration of learning prior to class and be prepared for it to be scored when you come in.

Successful completion of the all lectures, lab procedures and passing the final celebration of learning with a score of 76% or higher will give the candidate 24 hours of CME's: including: 6 New York State Paramedic Core Airway Management & Ventilation Hours, and 18 Hours of elective CME's. This Course will cover Ventilation (2 Hours), Capnography (1 Hours) and Oxygenation (0.5 hours) for National Registry Paramedic Recertification.
